## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### Membership Requirements (Riders)

- Riders require Full ESNZ Annual Membership to enter any Registered Classes
- Introductory Riders or Riders not registered with ESNZ can compete in Introductory Classes (85cm & under for Horses) on an Introductory Membership or Casual Membership Day Start (\$10 per day)

### Registration Requirements (Horses & Ponies)

- \$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy is **compulsory** and is payable by **all** horses/ponies competing in Jumping and/or Show Hunter
- High Points and Equitation Series classes – Full ESNZ Registration **PLUS** full Jumping Annual Start
- HOYQ (Horse of the Year Qualifier Classes) – Full ESNZ Registration **PLUS** full Jumping Annual Start in order to be allocated HOYQ points
- Unregistered horses/ponies (or horses/ponies registered with ESNZ with no annual discipline start for SJ/SH can start using a **Casual Jumping Levy** of \$10/ day or \$20/show. HOYQ points will **not** be allocated. (Note: \$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy is also payable and the rider must be a full member with ESNZ).

### Entry Restrictions & Conditions

- Pony, Junior, Amateur, Adult classes – for complete age and eligibility definition see SH rules on ESNZ website
- Ponies – may only enter one height category (excludes Equitation)
- Entries will be restricted to a maximum number of 5 classes (including Equitation) per day per horse/pony
- **Pony High Points** – ponies may only enter the correct height related category. All ponies must have a current height certificate which can be requested for viewing by show officials.
  - Cat A** 133cm & under
  - Cat B** over 133cm & up to 143cm
  - Cat C** over 143cm and up to & including 148cm
- Riders are allowed to ride one mount only in each Rider Equitation class. Pony riders can ride equitation in more than one Category.
- Equitation Pony rider classes are open to any aged pony rider.
- The following classes will count towards the SHW Equitation Series points – Classes 8,9,14,19,28,39 40,45,50,59.
- Horses or ponies competing using the Casual Jumping Levy are not eligible for HOYQ Points (but are eligible for prize money) and cannot compete in **any** National Series classes
- Rising Star Series - open to those horses not jumping over 90cm
- **Championship + Flat** for classes 41,47,52,61 will be run as a jumping class with a call back flat work-off for top 10 riders (or at judges discretion depending on class size). Only one horse/ rider combination can enter each championship class. Class will be judged 60% jump phase and 40% flat.
- **Classic** classes 11,16,21,30 will be run with a call back for top 10 riders (or at judges discretion depending on class size)
- **Area Team Challenge** refer attached criteria and entry form
- **# Tara Groenestein Memorial Trophy** points series. Tara Groenestein Memorial Trophy will be competed as an Amateur Points Series over the following shows, Auckland 17th – 18th November, Waitemata 1st – 2nd December 2018, Waikato 8th – 10th February 2019, with the final presentation at Waikato Show.
- All classes are run under ESNZ rules. Show Hunter rules can be downloaded from [www.nzequestrian.org.nz](http://www.nzequestrian.org.nz)
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter, combine or cancel classes.
- All competitors enter at their own risk and must be familiar with the Health and Safety Policy of both Show Hunter Waitemata and Woodhill Sands Equestrian Centre
- **ALL STALLION RIDERS MUST WEAR STALLION ARMBANDS WHEN MOUNTED**
- Warm-ups – name must be on whiteboard half an hour prior to the start time of the first class.

**Note: The Show Hunter Waitemata organising Committee reserves the right to cancel or alter the Teams Event if entries are not adequate**

### Teams:

1. An Area may enter more than one team
2. A Team should consist of a maximum of three horse/rider combinations and three pony/rider combinations (any category)
3. Teams can compete with less than the maximum number of combinations
4. A rider may only ride one mount per team and may only ride for one Area (note: a rider may ride a different mount in another team from the same Area)
5. Team members and mounts to be named prior to the commencement of the show.
6. Once a team member and mount has started competing they may substitute their horse or pony ONLY if the original mount is unsound (a vet certificate may be required). Any substitutions must be approved by the organizing committee.
7. Smaller Areas may join together to form a composite team, only if no-one else from their Area is attending the show. Prize money will be shared proportionately between these Areas. (Note: Composite teams require approval from the Show Hunter Waitemata Committee.)

### Selection & Entry:

1. Area groups are responsible for their own selection criteria
2. It is suggested that where possible reserves are selected
3. There is no fee to enter a team
4. Normal class entry fees for each class apply
5. No late team entries (after the start of competition on day one)
6. Complete and submit Area Team Entry Form by 27 November 2018
7. Each Area Team is requested to provide one Ground Crew Helper for each day, for example: gate steward, runner, etc

### Scoring:

1. The best three points scoring rounds (including Equitation) for each team member per day over two days will contribute to an overall team score (ie maximum possible score per rider is 36)
2. Points will be taken from individual rounds as per ESNZ scoring system. For example: If a team member wins a class 6 points will go towards your team score – 1<sup>st</sup>: 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup>: 4 points, 3<sup>rd</sup>: 3 points, 4<sup>th</sup>: 2 points, 5<sup>th</sup>: 1 point. Points will only be awarded for scores of 66% or higher.
3. In the event of a tie a count back will take place starting with the number of wins achieved by each team member during the show, if still tied then the number of seconds, etc until a final result is achieved.

### Prizes:

1. Prize money will be awarded to the Area Groups to be used specifically for Show Hunter related items – eg: gear, paint, tuition, etc

Rugs and ribbons to be retained by winning team members.

- Safe and proper use of equipment
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required
- Reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible
- Ensuring all accidents and incidents are reported
- Helping new participants, helpers and visitors to understand the right safety procedures and why they exist
- Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns
- Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.

### ESNZ BLUE CARD POLICY

The ESNZ Blue Card Process has been developed to keep riders safe and to support officials in their duty of care.

- Officials can exclude a rider from participating in a competition or entire event by issuing a Blue Card because the rider has received a serious injury, including concussion or suspected concussion.
- If a rider is issued with a Blue Card this will be recorded on their ESNZ profile and the rider will NOT be able to compete until they have received official medical clearance from a registered GP or medical specialist and sent this to ESNZ.
- If a rider who has been issued with a Blue Card competes without medical clearance or refuses to withdraw from an event, this may result in disciplinary action being taken through ESNZ
- Riders issued with a Blue Card at an event are advised NOT to drive home from the event and must arrange alternative transport for them and their horse/s.
